Kedarnath is an ancient and magnificent temple located in the Rudra Himalaya range. 'The name "Kedarnath" means "the lord of the field". Kedar is another name for lord Shiva, the protector, and the destroyer.

Badrinath is a holy town and a nagar panchayat in Chamoli district in the state of Uttarakhand, India. It is one of the four sites in India's Char Dham pilgrimage and gets its name from the Badrinath Temple.

Rishikesh is the name of Lord Vishnu which means "lord of senses". This place is also known as the place where Lord Vishnu defeated the powerful monster Madhu. Rishikesh is now famous as the world's Yoga Capltial.

The train journey starts from Mumbai to Delhi.

Day 2

Day 3

(Guptkashi)

Early breakfast and Checkout.

Depart for Guptkashi. Reach & Checkin.

Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel in Guptkashi.



Day 4

(Kedarnath)

Early breakfast and checkout. Proceed for Sitapur Parking(i.e.Base of Kedarnath). Then after 22 km yatra towards Kedarnath temple.

Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel near Mandir.

Day 5

(Guptakashi)

Early morning visit to Kedarnath temple.

After the visit have breakfast & check.

Then after descending to Sitapur Parking.


Proceed toward guptkashi.

Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel in guptkashi.

Day 6

(Badrinath)

Breakfast & Checkout. Proceed to Badrinath. Check in to the hotel by evening. Free time for leisure. Dinner & overnight stay at hotel.



Day 7

(Pipalkoti)

Early visit to Badrinath temple. After the visit have breakfast and checkout in. Enroute Sightseeing (i.e., Vyas Gufa & Mana village) After sightseeing proceed towards Pipalkoti. Reach & check in the evening. Dinner and overnight stay at a hotel in Pipalkoti.

Day 8

(Rishikesh)

Breakfast and proceed to Rishikesh.

Check in to the hotel by evening. Free time for leisure.

Dinner & overnight stay at hotel.

Day 9

Breakfast & Checkout. Enroute sightseeing (I.e.Ram Jhula, Mall Road & River Rafting (at your own cost) & Ganga aarti at Shatrughan Ghat) by evening proceed to Delhi station. Train journey towards Mumbai.

Tour Exclusion

- Any expense such as route change, date change, extra accommodation facilities, etc. incurred due to unforeseen, unavoidable forced majeure circumstances during the tour.

Cancellation Policy

- If cancellations are made within 0-15 days before the start date of the trip, 100% on total amount of trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% on total amount of trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% on total amount of trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
